



**MealTime** is your school's new cafeteria POS (Point of Sale) replacing the cash register/prepaid ticket system.

Placing funds on your child's account in advance helps speed the cafeteria line, allowing your child more time to eat.

This new system not only helps speed the line, it also provides parents with:

- An alternative method of prepaying for your child's meal and a la carte items
- Allows a parent to monitor what your children are eating each day
- Gives a parent the option of allowing their child to spend the funds on school meals only, no snacks.

Simply logging onto the schools website and clicking the MealTime Online Logo will bring you to the MealTime site to be able to place funds via credit card into your child's/ children's account and view your child's account.

No more fumbling for lunch money during morning rush!

The money stays on your child's account if not used within the school year

### Did You Know?

By clicking on the MealTime On Line Link from the Freehold Township District Website Home Page you can then click onto My MealTime to create an account for your student. This will enable you to:

- View your child's account activity including current balance and history of purchases to keep the account current.
- Update your MealTime OnLine Profile to receive automatic e-mail notifications of low balance warning.
- Make Deposits with any Discover, VISA or MasterCard debit or credit cards. Payments will be reflected in student's account within 48 hours.

**MealTime Pay Online** makes it easy for parents and households to conveniently and securely track their child's meal account activity and make deposits from the security and convenience of their home or office. From any Internet-connected computer parents, guardians and households can:

Monitor their student's cafeteria purchase activity without calling the school. Viewable information includes date of transaction, items purchased, meal period and price.

Make deposits at their convenience, using their Visa, Mastercard or Discover card (debit or credit) with total security. Deposit receipts are sent promptly to the depositor's email address.

Check their student's account balances whenever it is convenient, avoid surprises and last minute scrambling for lunch money.

Have a convenient reminder sent to their email address to let them know that a child's account balance has reached a threshold that they set themselves.

Rest assured knowing their child's lunch money isn't going to get lost, stolen or taken from them while on the way to or at school. And, their child will always have a positive balance at lunch time.
